Pit move in begins on Thursday July 18, 2024 at 12:00pm. Camping is permitted however shore power must be paid directly to Pike Peak International Raceway. Gates will remain open until 8:00pm on Friday. You will need a PPIR wristband this weekend in addition to a Colorado Karting Tour wrist band.

Our volunteers and staff continue to do a great job on and off the track! Please treat our volunteers and staff with respect, please follow the directions they give you, they are here to ensure a safe and fair event for everyone. Take a moment to thank them as you see them throughout the weekend.

Transponders are **NOT** available for rent through the Colorado Karting Tour or PPIR. Transponders are **required** for all sessions on race days. Your fastest lap during morning warmup will set the order for qualifying. **Competitors are solely and directly responsible for ensuring the transponder number provided during registration and in their MotorsportReg profile is correct.**

Only tires purchased through the Colorado Karting Tour or an Authorized Colorado Karting Tour Reseller are permitted on race days. **Formal protests can be filed at the registration desk. You will also need \$100 in cash to make a formal protest. Should you need to speak to a race official you may make that request at the registration desk.** We have updated our rule on loss of tire and ballast. The supplement is attached to this packet and is available is also available on our website. Please check your kart to ensure everything is properly attached and also check that you have not left any tools on the kart before entering the track.

Attached to this letter for each round are the event schedules, track map, and pre-tech certification sheets (one for each round). Your helmet must be checked and 2024 sticker applied prior to entering the track. Your kart must have a presenting sponsor sticker and class sponsor sticker, they are available at registration. If you are competing in multiple classes with the same kart ensure you have a class and weight sticker on your kart for both classes. **Competitors are solely and directly responsible for the safety of their race karts and equipment. The Colorado Karting Tour does not assume any liability for the safety and/or technical compliance of a competitor's race kart or equipment.**

The event schedule is subject to change. Live results may be available on Speedhive and/or Race Monitor.

There is a mandatory Driver's Meeting on race days. Mechanics, team owners, and parents are encouraged to attend. Competitors failing to attend the Driver's Meeting may receive a penalty. **Competitors are solely and directly responsible for knowing the rules and adhering to them.**

Miscellaneous Procedures

Loss of Ballast or Wheel (UPDATED)

In the case of ballast or a wheel coming off a competitor's kart during a competition event, the competitor shall be disqualified from that competition event in the form of a technical disqualification (DQ). Such disqualification is only applied to that particular on-track session, and not the entire event. If this occurs during the main event, this DQ may be used as a drop. However, if the competitor has lost ballast on track, they may not retrieve that ballast for use on the scales. If the competitor cannot make the minimum weight without the ballast that came off the kart, they will receive a DQ that cannot be dropped.

The rule titled Loss of Ballast or Wheel in the Colorado Karting Tour 2024 Competition Rules has been retitled Loss of: and revised to the following. This update supersedes the prior rule and is effective 14JUL24. Disqualifications cannot be dropped.

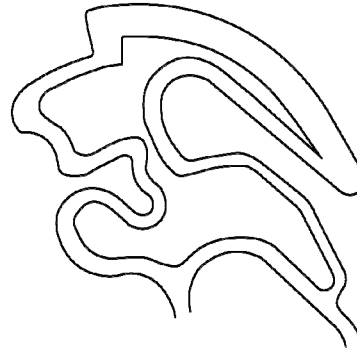

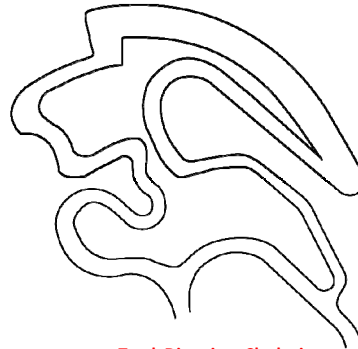

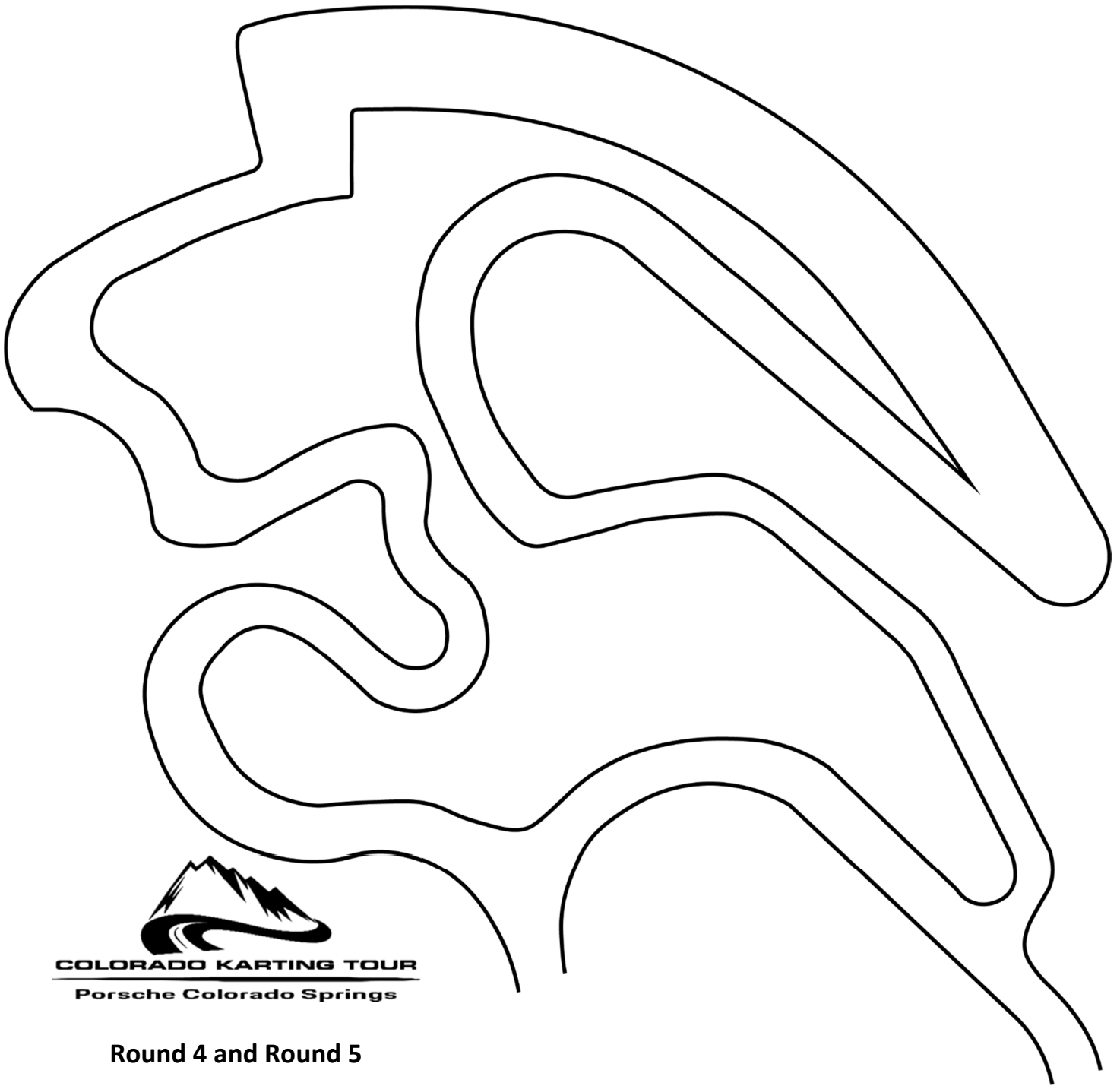
